Prostate cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death in men in the United States. More than 26,000 men will die from prostate cancer this year.

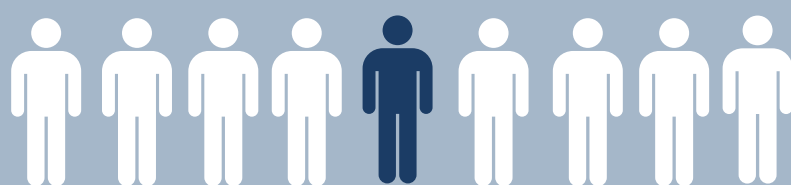

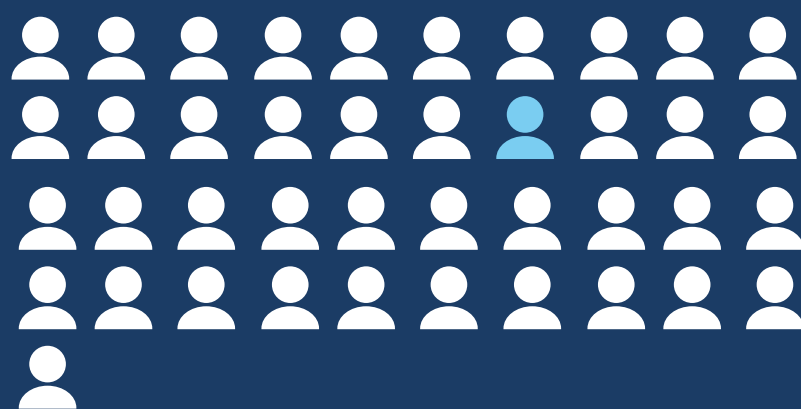
